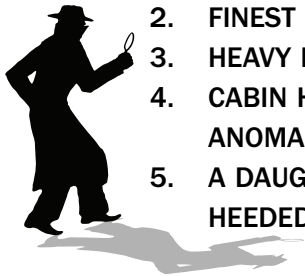


# Scrambled holmes
